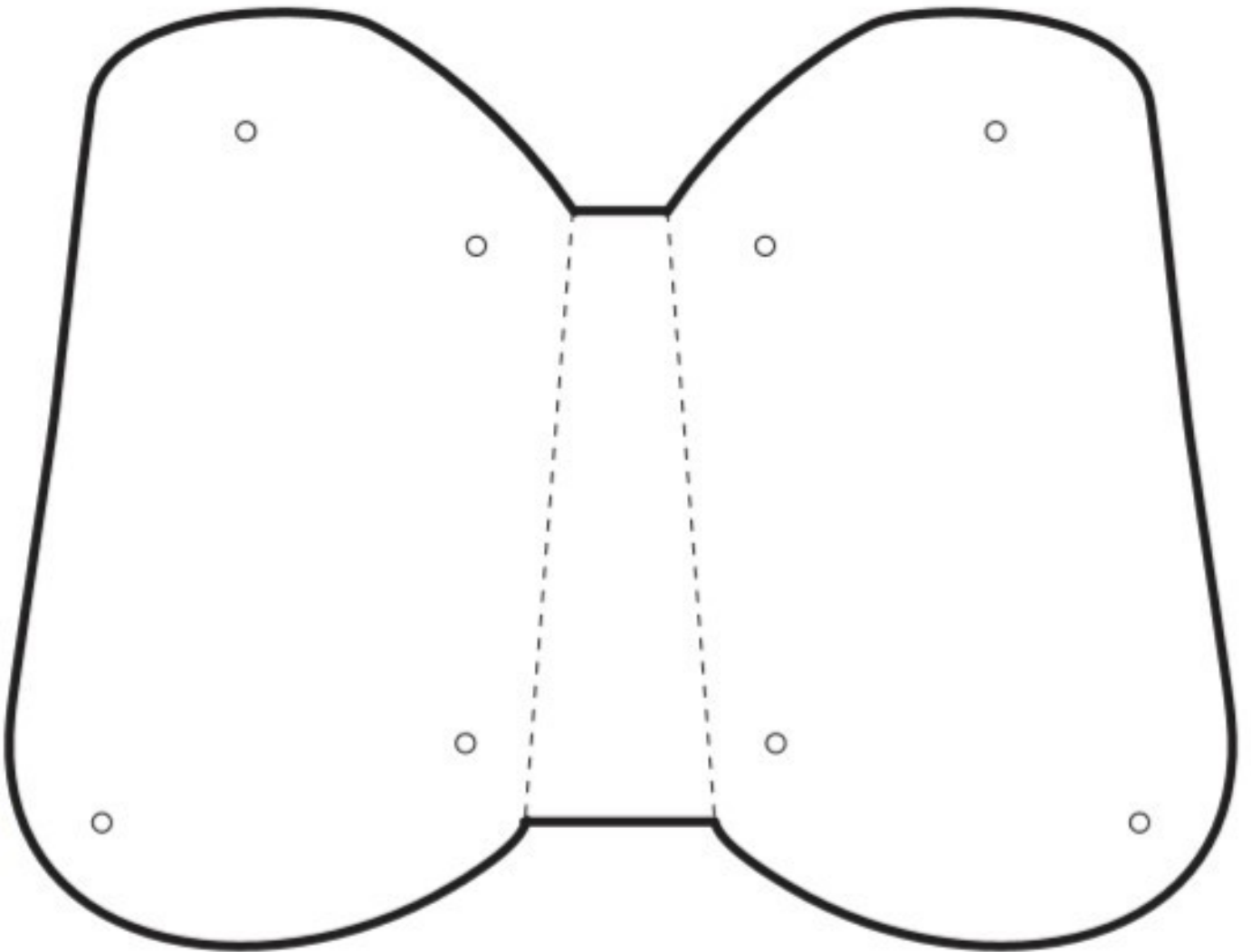
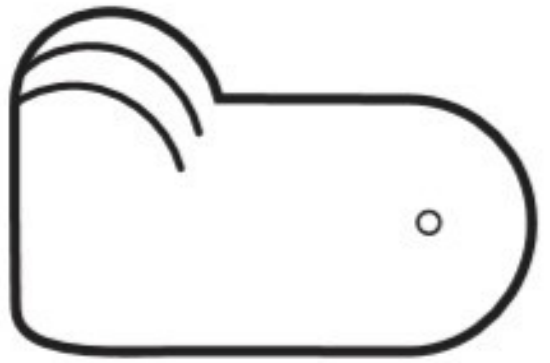
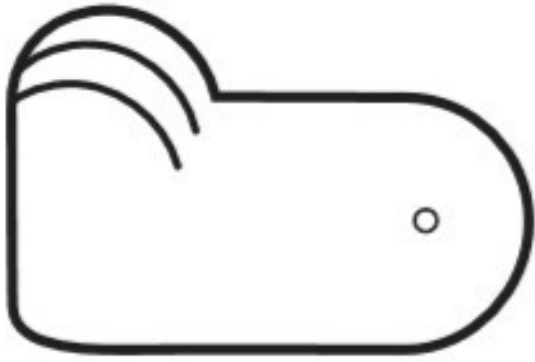
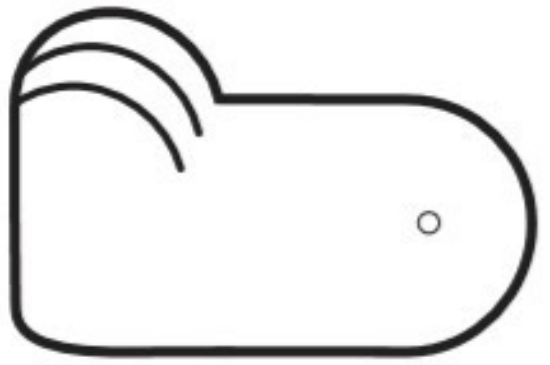
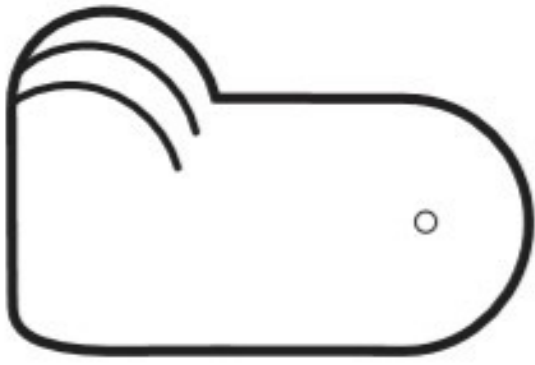


Dog String Puppet

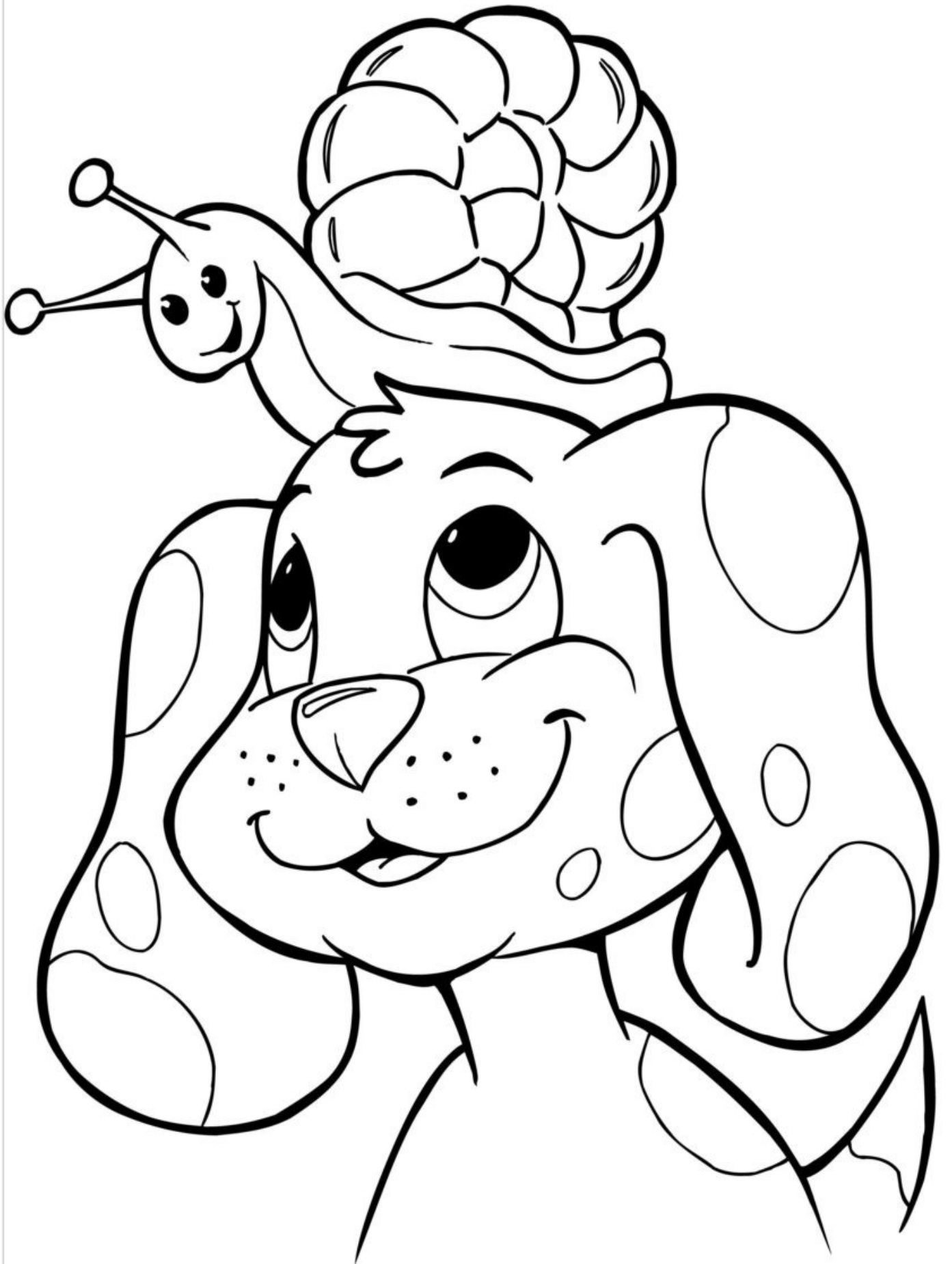
Instructions

1. Decorate and cut out each part of the puppet.
2. Punch holes through each of the small circles on the template.
3. Fold the body of the dog along the two dashed lines (the fold becomes the dog's belly).
4. Glue the ears onto each side of the face. Use split pins or glue to attach the legs, the head and the tail to the body.
5. Tape one piece of string to the back of the head and another piece of string to the back of the body near the tail. Attach the other end of each string to a wooden ruler or pop sticks.
