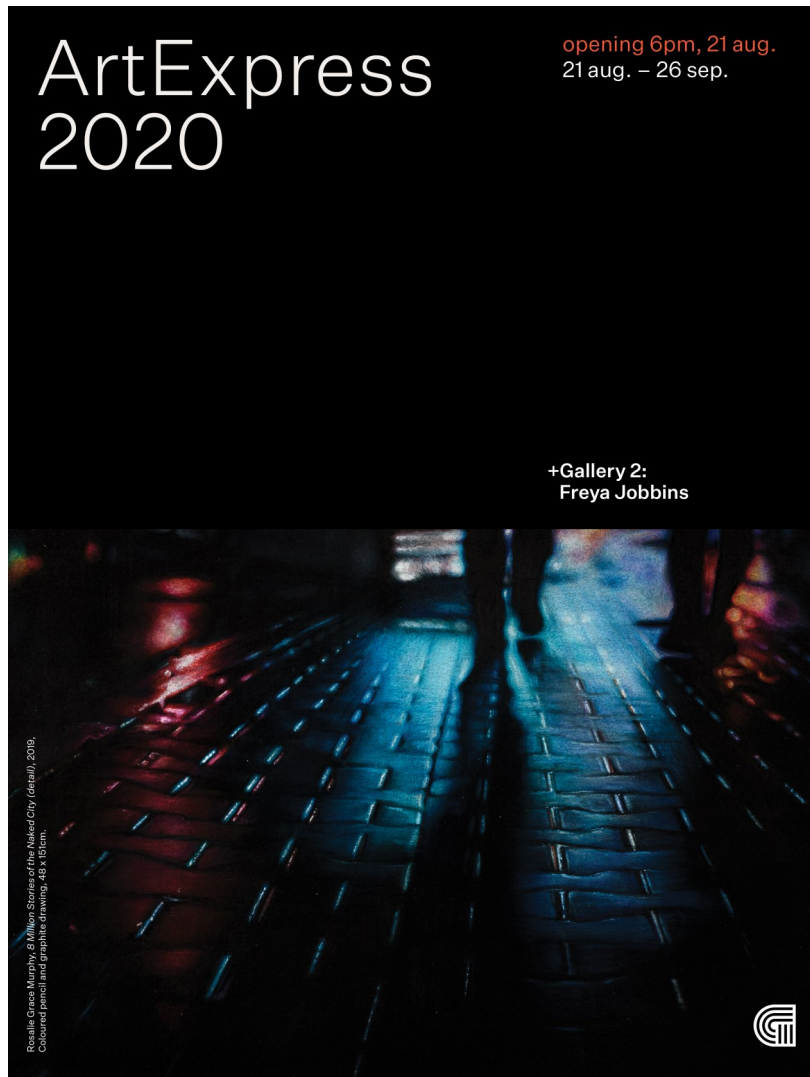

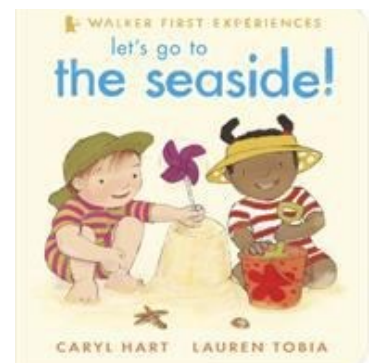

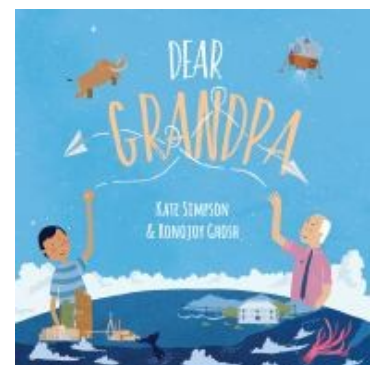

ANIMAL ICE CREAM CONE DRAWING

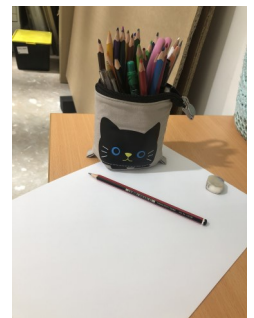
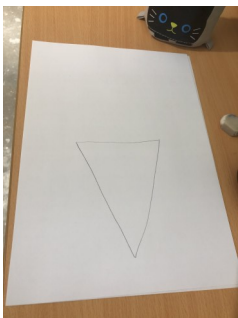
These are ceramics pieces titled 'Melting Away' by Emily Calcagno Chalco from St Patrick's Marist College. They are on exhibition at Goulburn Regional Art Gallery as part of the ARTEXPRESS 2020 exhibition.



We are going to draw animal ice cream scoops.

You will need:

- * A piece of blank paper
- * A pencil
- * Crayons, pencils or textas for colouring

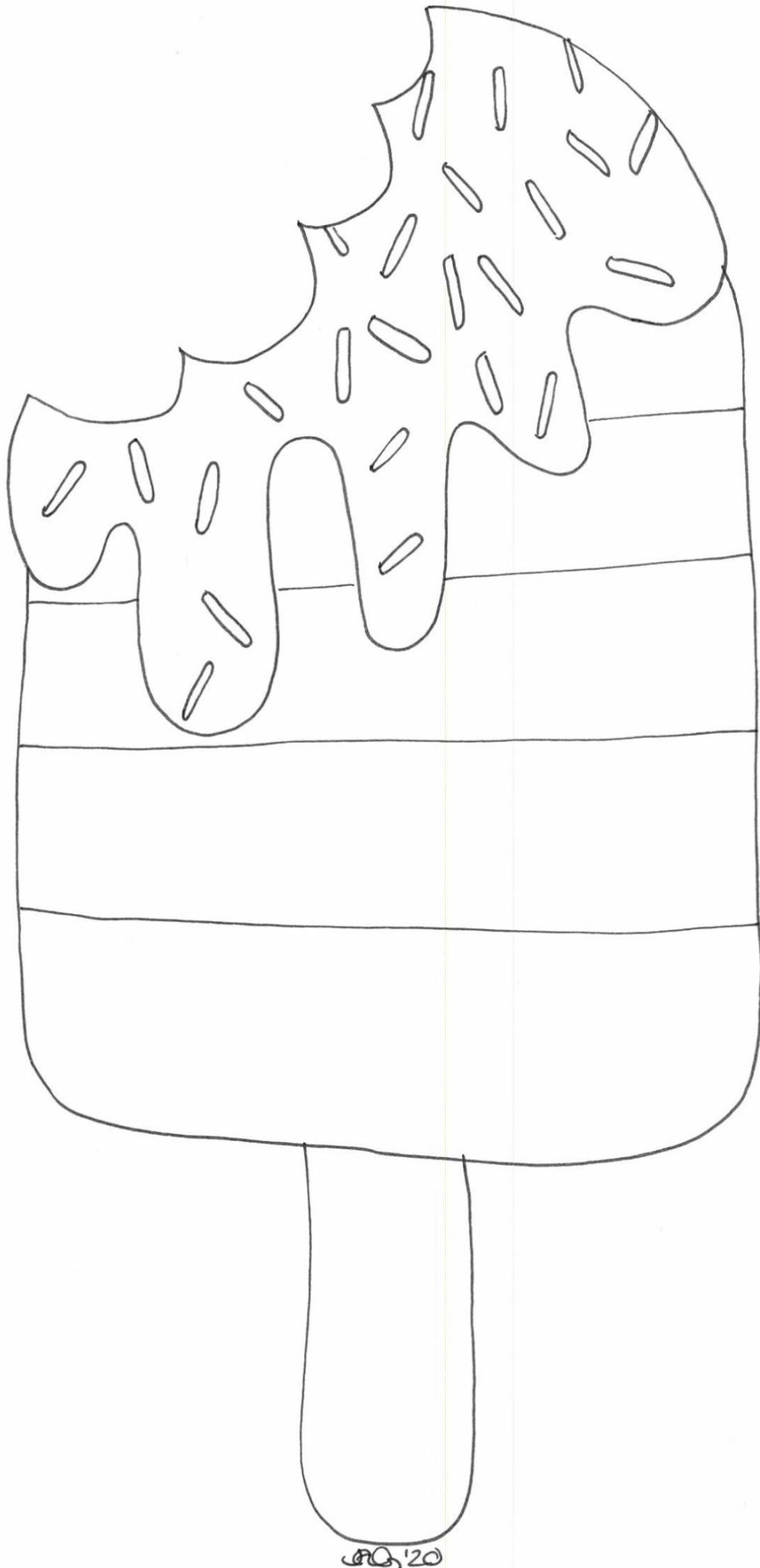


- 1) Draw a pointy triangle (this is your ice cream cone)
- 2) Draw a circle on top of the triangle (this is your animal ice cream scoop head)
- 3) Draw eyes, nose, mouth in your circle
- 4) Draw the extra bits your animal needs - ears? Spikes? Fur? Scales? Fins? Shell?
- 5) Colour your animal ice cream cone
- 6) Think of another animal - draw it

Lets go on a **Ice Cream flavour Hunt**

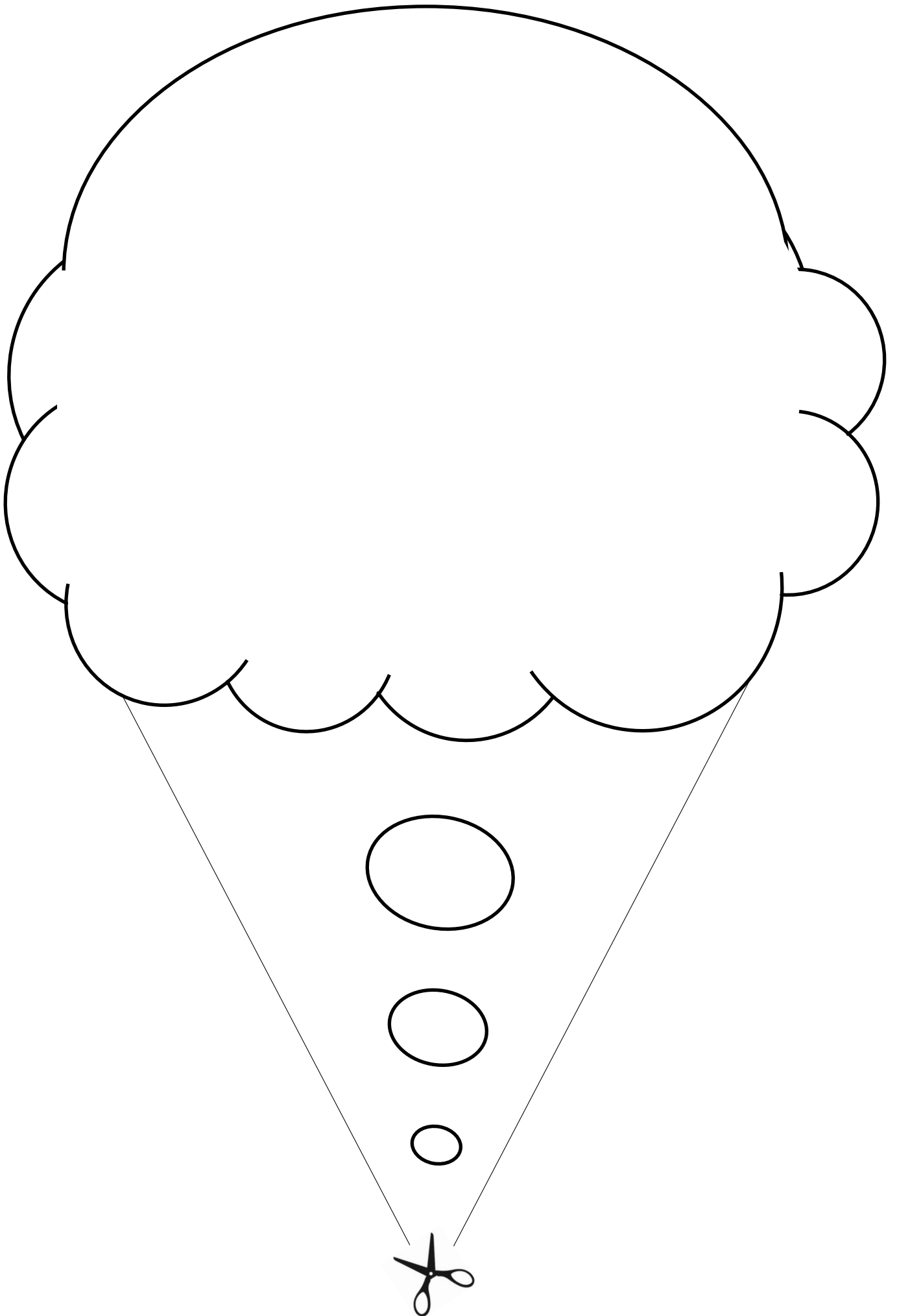
Have a think about these flavours of ice cream ?

Give it a tick when you do

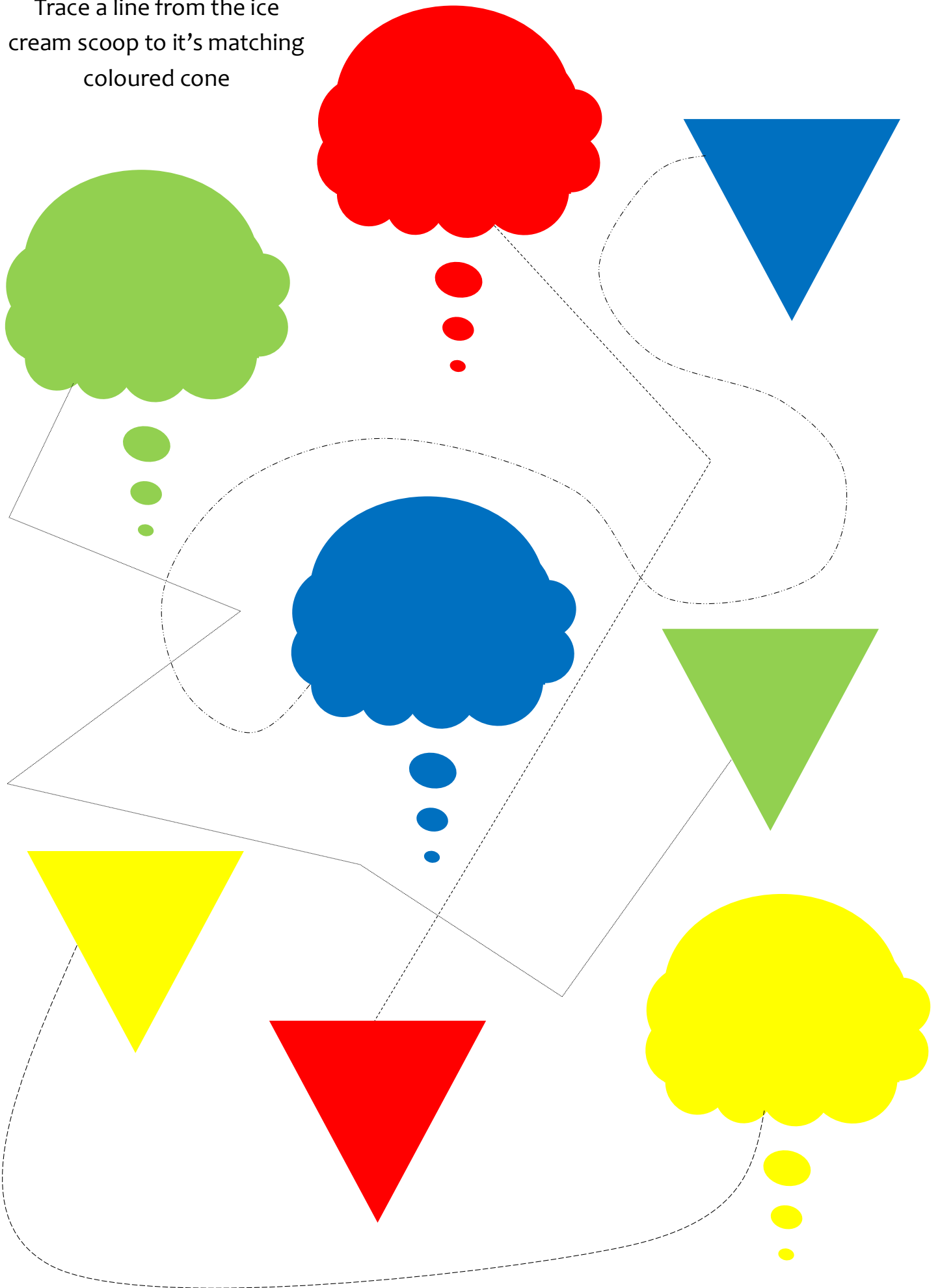


Something to CUT



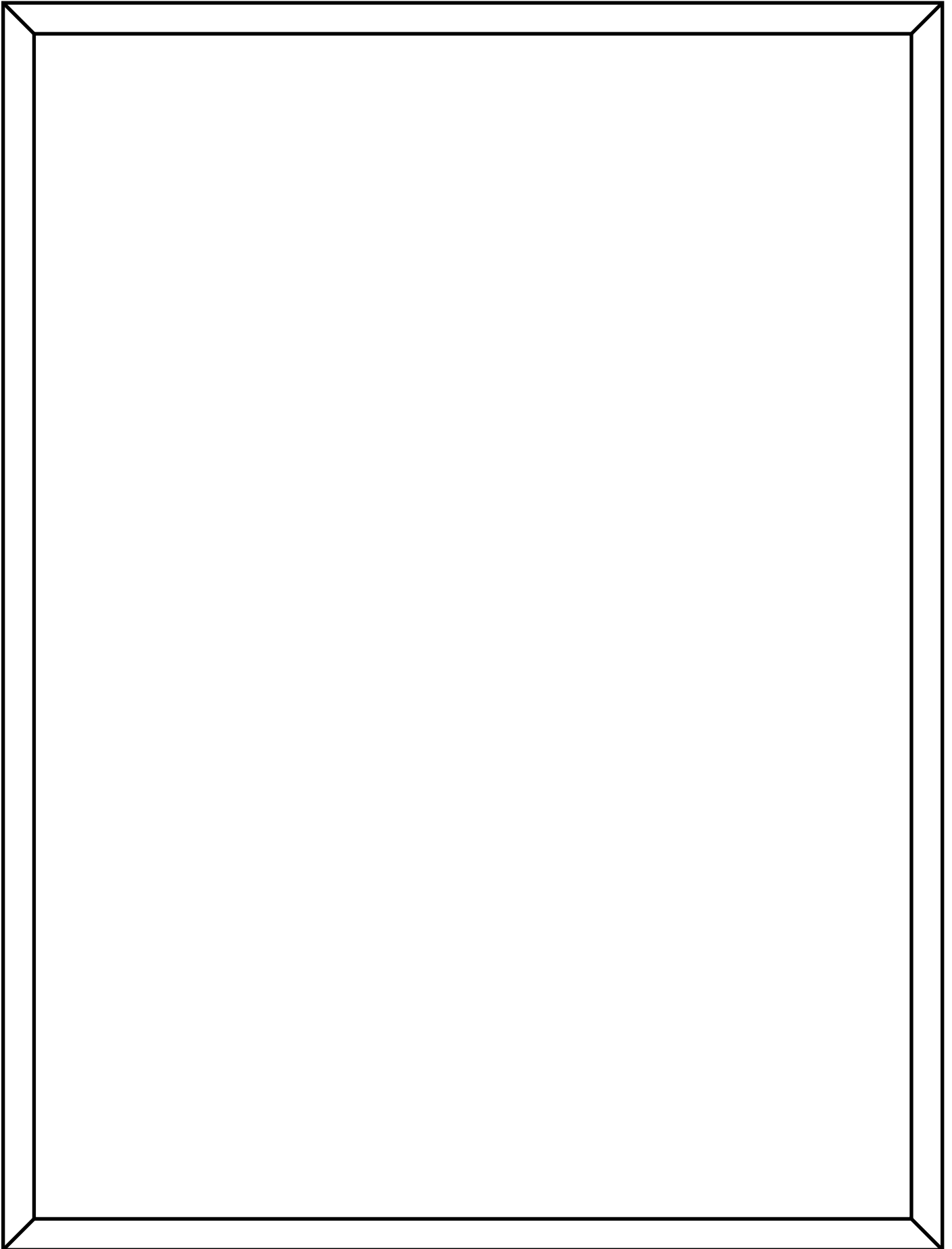
Something to TRACE
