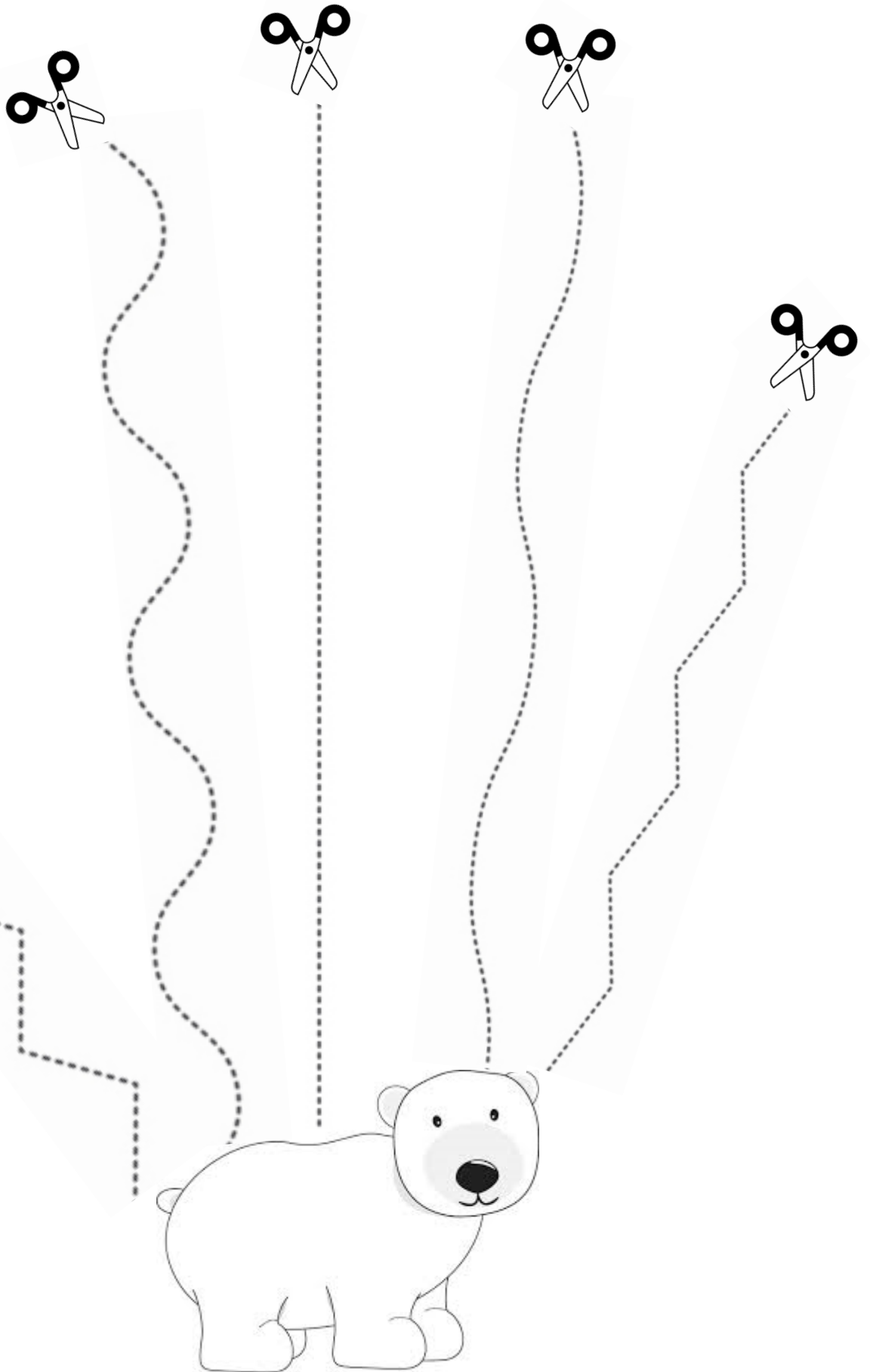

What to do with your boxes?



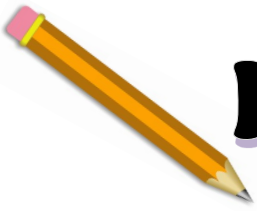
- Stack them as high as you can

- Use recycled materials to make a box creature



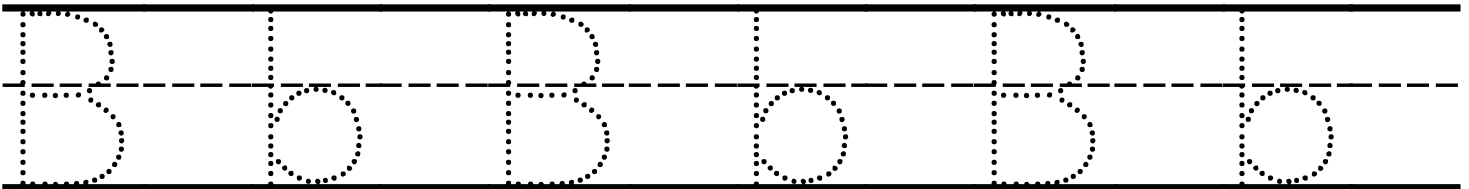
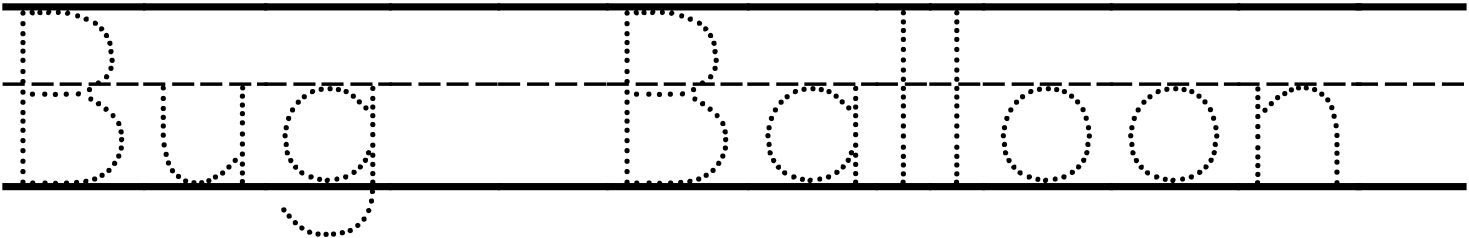
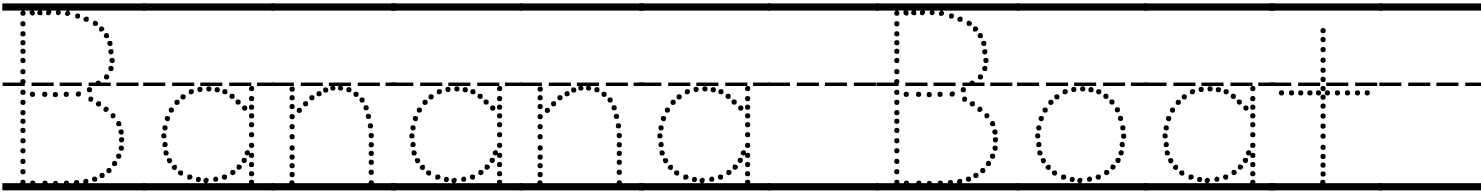
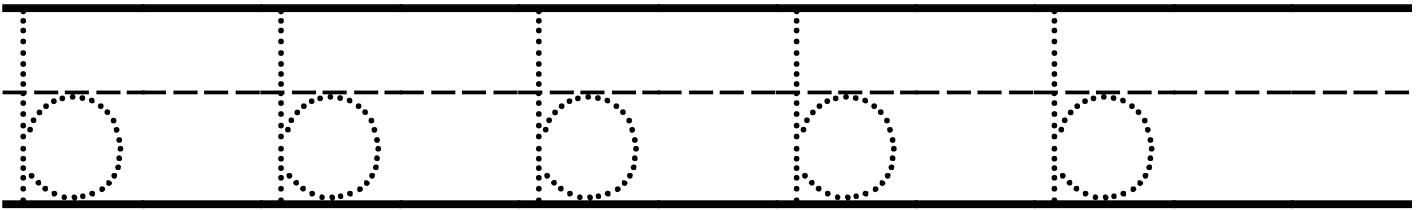
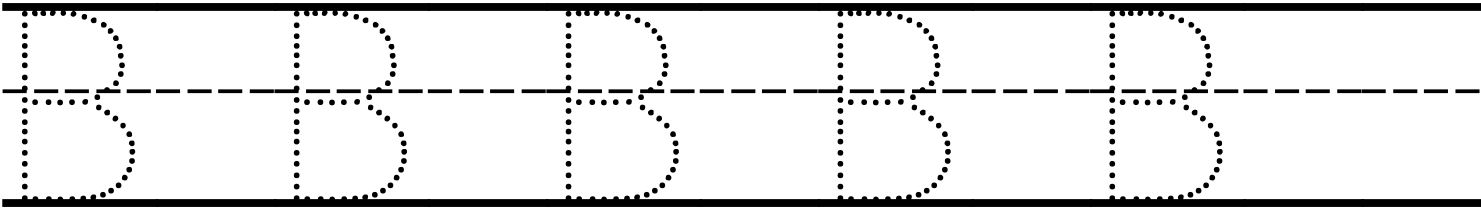
