The Goulburn Art Award has been running since 1992 and is open to artists who live within a 120km radius of Goulburn. The award is designed to support artistic practices in the region and present the diversity and vibrancy of those practices to our audience. The award is open to works in any medium and in 2024 will be judged by Bree Pickering, Director, National Portrait Gallery. This is a non-acquisitive award and there are no thematic requirements for artworks entered in the award.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Goulburn Art Award is a non-acquisitive award open to artists aged 18+ living within a 120km radius of Goulburn CBD. This includes the Southern Highlands, Yass, Canberra and Wollongong. Refer to [this map](#).
2. Employees of the Goulburn Regional Art Gallery and Goulburn Mulwaree Council and their immediate families are ineligible to enter the competition. Immediate family means any of the following: child, stepchild, grandchild, niece, nephew, sibling, stepsibling or first cousin.
3. To be eligible, all entrants must submit a complete online application by the due date.
4. A non-refundable entry fee of \$30.00 applies per applicant.
5. All entered artwork must have been completed in the last 12 months between **April 2023 and April 2024** and be the original work of the artist. If the practitioner has been assisted, any contributors must be identified.
6. The online entry including completed entry form, images, CV, artist statement and entry fee must be received by **5pm Friday 5 April 2024**.
7. Only one work can be submitted for consideration per artist.
8. You must provide a high resolution image of your artwork to support your entry.
9. Images must be high resolution JPEGs suitable for print and online but no larger than 5MB in total.
10. Image file names must include the artist's name and title of the artwork being submitted to the Award.
11. Due to space limitations, only finalists artworks will be hung in the exhibition. Finalists will be notified via email.
12. Two dimensional works must be no larger than 200 x 200cm including framing, and be fitted with two D rings, or other suitable hanging devices.
13. Three dimensional work must not exceed a volume of more than 100cm cubed and must not exceed more than 200cm in any direction.
14. Any work must not exceed 30 kilograms in weight.
15. Time based works must be submitted with a digital link provided to view and download of the entire work (maximum 10 mins length, MP4 files only, please provide a link to a high-resolution version of your work).
16. Artworks that are not archival in nature will be assessed in addition to their suitability for display in a gallery environment (i.e. exposed botanical elements and untreated timbers).
17. By submitting an entry, you agree to Goulburn Regional Art Gallery reproducing images of entered works in promotional, educational and marketing material associated with the Award. The Gallery will attribute the artist in all instances, unless it is not possible to do so.
18. The work must be available to exhibit from **17 May – 22 June 2024**.
19. If selected as a finalist, your artwork must be delivered to the Gallery during opening hours, **9am – 5pm on Thursday 9 May 2024**.
20. Artwork must be labelled with artists name title, year, medium and dimensions.
21. Artwork must be accompanied with installation instructions and all equipment necessary to display the work. If you do not supply the necessary hanging devices, instructions or if your 2D framed or canvas artwork is not fitted with d-latches or other appropriate hanging device, we may not be able to install your artwork.
22. If a finalist, artwork must be collected from the Gallery during opening hours **9am – 5pm on Tuesday 25 June 2024**.
23. The Winner will be contacted, as relevant, by the Gallery to fulfil their prize.
